## Net'sGo User's Guide

### **Description:**

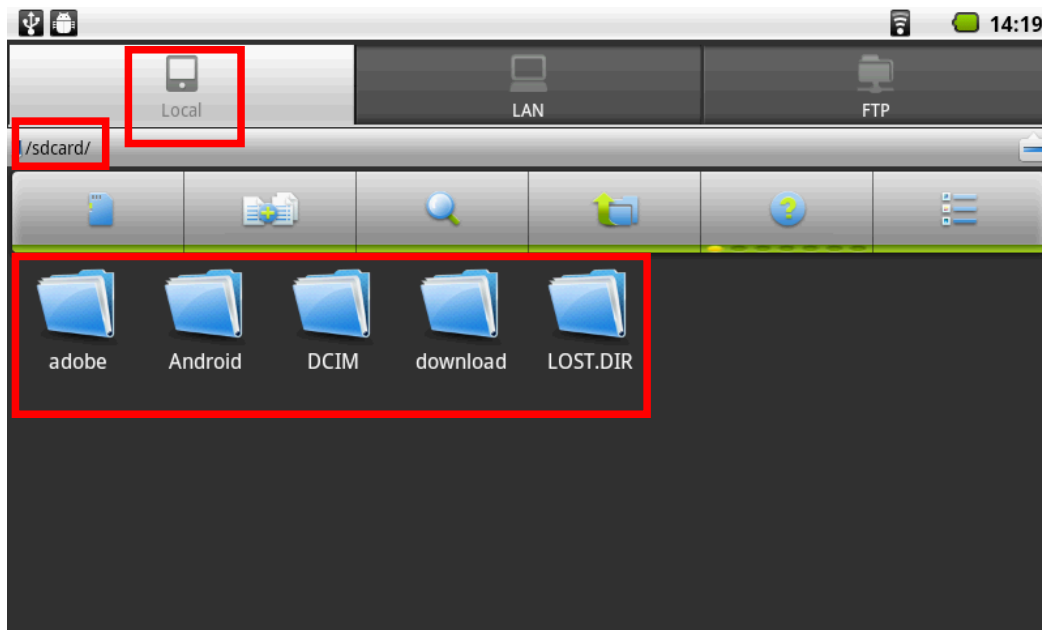
The location of external SD Card for Net'sGo has been changed under the new Android OS Version 2.2 . Different from the previous Android 1.6, the external SD card location is now named as "**Internalstorage**" and the actual free internal flash storage space is now named as "**sdcard**".

This will free users from the need for always having an external SD card inserted to Net'sGo which is required by some installed applications.

To view the contents of both "**sdcard**" (the free internal storage space) and "**Internalstorage**" (the external SD card), you need to have "**ES File Browser**" installed on Net'sGo. ("**ES File Browser**" can be downloaded from the Android Market if it is not pre-installed on Net'sGo)

#### **A. How to locate "sdcard" (the free internal storage space):**

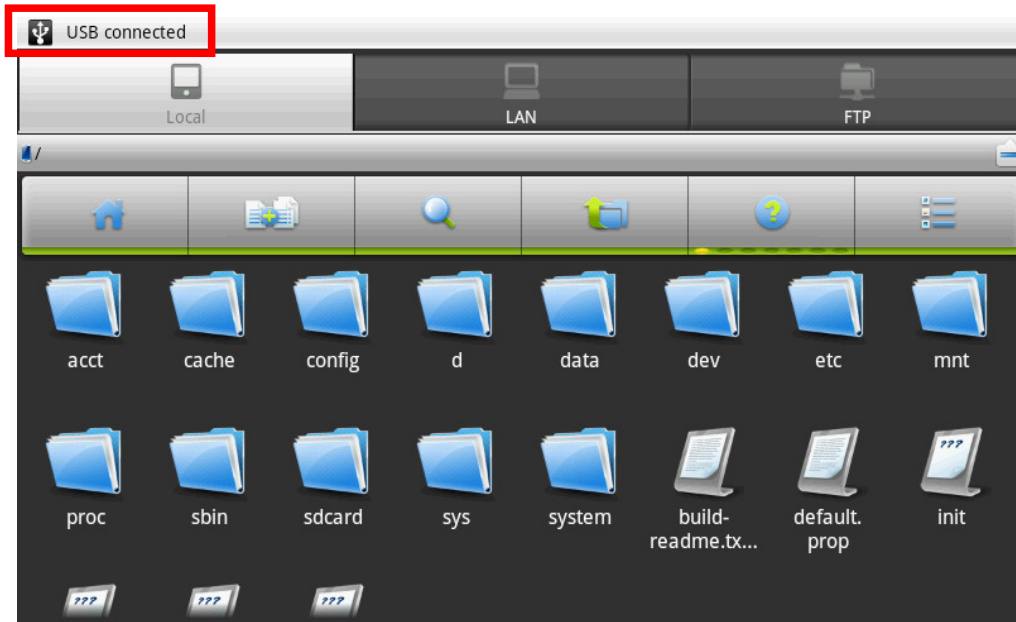
Launch the "**ES File Browser**" and you will enter the path: /sdcard/ as default under the "Local". This is the actual internal flash storage space of Net'sGo available for use by the users. Most downloaded files, APKs, and folders created by the installed applications are all stored at this location.



B. How to locate “**Internalstorage**” (the external SD card):

Firstly, you need to insert a SD card into the SD card slot on the Net’sGo. Once the SD card is inserted, you will see the messages on the upper left corner of Net’sGo screen before it is ready for access.





Press “Home” icon to go to the root directory and press “mnt” folder:



Press “internalstorage” folder under “mnt” will open up all the files and folders contained in the inserted external SD card:
